- 1. All interested Tenderers are invited to participate in the open procedure public procurement of works on Rehabilitation of road-railway bridge over the Danube River - "Pančevački most" - central steel lattice construction under the bridge deck and approaching railway structures on the left bank of the Danube River, first phase**
- 2. All local or foreign legal entities registered for the subject-matter activity who fulfill the required conditions specified in the Public Procurement Law, Article 45 (Official Gazette of the Republic of Serbia, No. 39/2002) have the right to participate in the procedure and they are obliged to submit documentation as an evidence of fulfilling the requirements pursuant to the Public Procurement Law, Article 46 and the Client's tender documents:**
 - **Extract from the Company Register Agency, i.e. from the competent authority in the country of registered seat for performing the activity subject to the public procurement, namely from the competent authority in the country of registered seat**
 - **Corresponding and valid licenses for performing the above-mentioned works issued by the Ministry for Capital Investments, (I132G2; I142G1)**
 - **Certificate proofing that no effective judicial or administrative measure of ban on performing the activity subject to the public procurement has been delivered to the Tenderer within two years prior to the announcement of the public invitation**
 - **Certificate that all due taxes, contribution fees and other public charges for the current year are settled, in accordance with regulations applicable in the country of the registered seat for the current year.**
 - **Statement of financial standing issued by the National Bank of Serbia and for foreign Tenderers the statement of an authorized auditor**
 - **Bank guarantee for participation in procedure of award of above-mentioned works**
 - **And other documentation specified in the tender documents.**

If Tenderer does not participate in the capacity of a Sole Contractor, he has to provide complete documentation for all involving parties, pursuant to the Public Procurement Law, Articles 45 and 46.

3. Tender documents can be taken over within 25 days from the day of announcement publication in the Official Gazette of the Republic of Serbia in the premises of the Land Development Agency, room 306, between 9 a.m. and 3 p.m. against receipt of payment of a fee for taking over the tender documents.

Tenderers have to pay a non-refundable fee in the amount of RSD 6000.00 (including VAT) at the current account No. 840-93647-02 of the Belgrade Land Development Agency EP, indicating the purpose of payment: purchase of tender documents for the execution of works on **rehabilitation of road-railway bridge over the Danube River - "Pančevački most" - central steel lattice construction under the bridge deck and approaching railway structures on the left bank of the Danube River, first phase.**

4. Deadline for tender submission is 45 days from the date of publishing of this invitation in the Official Gazette of the Republic of Serbia and tenders shall be submitted by mail to the following address: Direkcija za građevinsko zemljište i izgradnju Beograda J.P., Njegoševa 84, 11000 Beograd (Belgrade Land Development Agency EP, 84, Njegoševa Street, 11000 Belgrade) or delivered by hand to the clerk's office of the Agency every working day between 9 a.m. and 3 p.m. in the sealed envelope with indication: "Ne otvaraj – ponuda" (Tender - do not open) and specified work the tender is submitted for. If the last date for tender submission is non-working day or national holiday, the deadline for tender submission shall be the first next working day.

Tenderer shall write its name, address and telephone number at the back side of the envelope.

5. After expiry of deadline, the Commission will open the tenders. All Tenderers will be subsequently informed on date and time of tender opening. The tender opening procedure will be open for attendance by authorized Tenderers' representatives who will give their powers of attorney to the Commission prior to opening of tenders. Untimely and incomplete tenders shall not be taken into consideration.
